

T/37 Radio-Controlled Racing Sloop 2024 Northwest Regional Championship Regatta Saturday, May 11, 2024 at Sudden Valley Marina, 6 Marina Dr., Bellingham, WA

# NOTICE OF RACES [PRELIMINARY]

This regatta is hosted by Pacific Northwest Model Yacht Club (**PNMYC**) in cooperation with Sudden Valley Marina.

# 1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined by World Sailing.
- 1.2 The Organizing Authority is PNMYC.
- 2. This Notice modifies Racing Rules of Sailing 31, and Appendices A2, E8 and G1:
- 2.1 Boats may touch marks of the course while racing. This deletes RRS 31.
- 2.2 One worst score will be excluded from a boat's total score for every **four** races scored. This modifies RRS A2.
- 2.3 Class- or PNMYC-posted sail identification schemes (contrasting, bold, narrow, min. 3" high) are permitted. This modifies App. E8 (4" high) and G1.

## 3. This Notice modifies T-37 Class Rules:

- 3.1 To prevent damage to other boats, each boat shall mount a resilient bow bumper from the deck down to within 5/8" above an extension of the hull bottom plane.
- 3.2 Jib boom counterweights shall not extend beyond the bow. The forward end shall be round or blunt.
- 3.3 The base of the mast shall be stepped in the bottom of the boat and may be manually adjustable fore and aft.
- 3.4 Removable ballast is permitted within or above the hull. Such ballast may be altered between races, provided 5.0 lb. weight is maintained.
- 3.5 All entered boats must pass the **righting moment test** described at PNMYC.org and, if necessary, carry corrector weights while racing.

### **4 CHANGES TO NOTICE OF RACE**

4.1 Changes to the Notice of Race shall be posted via PNMYC.org.

### 5. ELIGIBILITY

- 5.1 The regatta is open to all class-legal T37 radiocontrolled racing sloops, and to those modified only as permitted by this Notice.
- 5.2 To enter the regatta, complete the entry form and return it to the indicated address with your entry fee.
- 5.3 Entry fee is **\$20.** Late entry: \$25.
- 5.4 Early mail or email registration is requested. Regatta forms, fee, and optional PNMYC membership fee will be accepted on site prior to the deadline.

### 6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1 The deadline for receipt of all entry documents and fees is **10:00 AM** on regatta day.
- 6.2 The competitor's meeting will be at 10:30 AM.
- 6.3 The Warning Signal for race one will be at **11:00** AM.
- 6.4 There will be a lunch break between two racing sessions.
- 6.5 If a split fleet heat format is used, the entrants for each race will be divided to compete in two heats.
- 6.6 The number of races will depend on the weather conditions and time of day, at the race committee's discretion. The goal is to complete six or more races.
- 6.7 If six or more races have been completed, no start sequence will begin after 4 PM.
- 6.8 The awards ceremony will begin near the sailing venue soon after the last race has been completed.

# 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND NOTICES TO COMPETITORS:

7.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the Competitor's Meeting and on the notice board at the sailing venue.

7.2 Notices to Competitors will be posted at the race committee station.

7.3 All boats must be weighed prior to sailing. Minimum weight, fully rigged is 5.0 pounds. Weighing will be conducted between 9:45 and 10:15 on race day.

### 8. RACING AREAS

8.1 Racing will be off the western shore of Lake Whatcom

# 9. SCORING:

9.1 The low-point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, as modified in this Notice.

9.2 The number of race scores excluded from a yacht's total score will depend upon the number of races or heats completed. One worst score will be excluded for every **four** races scored. This modifies RRS A2.

### 10 AWARDS:

10.1 PNMYC will present first, second, and third place awards.

10.2 The winner's name will be engraved on the championship perpetual trophy, which the winner shall return to PNMYC prior to the 2025 T-37 Regional Class Championship Regatta.
